1969 Gallery presents *Just As I Am*, featuring seven new paintings by Caleb Hahne and a group exhibition of artists Hahne admires: Sara Anstis, Inka Essenhigh, Danny Ferrell, Chris Lloyd and Claire Tabouret.

In Caleb Hahne's *Alameda (Rogelio)*, a young man sits on a rearing horse, reigns in hand. His clothes are muted and modern, his yellow and white trucker cap flashing color, adding to the sense that this young man is claiming and holding his space in the American West. In a departure from many of Caleb's past works in which we see a young man from behind or the side, this figure faces us confidently. In *Feel/Fill*, movement and the hypnotic gradient of the background is shown and magnified in glass of water, with a deviation in color from some of Hahne's previous water glass paintings, which were informed by California drought and wildfire.

The works shown simultaneously with Hahne's paintings converse with each other and the viewer. Stylistically, these painters are working with smoothly rendered forms and bold colors, with the human figure as their primary focus. The drawings of Sara Anstis bring us into light colored, somewhat surreal scenes free of patriarchy and filled with eros, humor, and figures reminiscent of myth. Danny Ferrell's quietly sexy paintings depict queer men in the mundane.

*Just As I Am* marks Caleb Hahne's debut exhibition as a represented artist at 1969 Gallery, along with our debut exhibition at 1969's new Tribeca gallery space. To mark this special occasion, we are thrilled to present this celebration of Caleb and painters he admires for an exhibition that will generate a dialogue off the walls about influences and the broader community of painters.







**Caleb Hahne** received a BFA in Fine Arts from Rocky Mountain College of Art and Design in 2014 and currently lives and works in CO. He was an artist in residence at ShowPen from September 2013 to August 2014 and is currently in residency at RedLine Contemporary Art Center, both located in Denver. In 2020, he was in the three-person show *Tell Them About Me* at the 1969 Gallery. He recently completed a traveling artist residency with Southwest American Bullet (SWAB). His art has been included in multiple solo and group exhibitions in Denver, New York, Los Angeles, San Francisco, Oakland, Portland, Montreal, Berlin, and the United Kingdom and recently at MCA Denver as well as the New Museum, NY in collaboration with Adidas. Hahne has been featured in Juxtapoz, Hi-Fructose, and Booooooom.com. Denver Westword named Hahne one of the 100 Colorado Creatives of 2014 and one of the Top 10 Artists to watch in 2015. He is listed as one of the top 10 contemporary artists under 40 by Wide Walls.

**Sara Anstis** received a BFA in Studio Art and Sociology at Concordia University (Montreal, CA) in 2013 and an MFA in Fine Art from Valand Academy (Gothenburg, SE) in 2016. In 2018, she completed the Drawing Year Postgraduate Programme at the Royal Drawing School (London, UK). She has received grants from the Elizabeth Greenshields Foundation (CA), Jerwood Arts (UK), and the Anna-Lisa Thomson foundation (SE) amongst others. She has shown her work in the U.S., Canada, and Europe, and she will participate in a forthcoming show with Galerie Derouillon in Paris. She works and lives wherever she finds good light.

**Danny Ferrell** received his BFA with Distinction in Painting from Pennsylvania State University, State College and his MFA in Painting from Rhode Island School of Design. He lives, works in Pittsburgh, PA, where he also teaches at Carnegie Mellon University as an adjunct professor. His work has shown in the U.S., Canada, and France, including solo shows Pittsburgh's Center for the Arts, Marinaro in New York City, and most recently at PACT, in Paris.

**Inka Essenhigh** received her Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from Columbus College of Art & Design in 1992 and her Master of Fine Art from School of Visual Arts in 1994. She recently completed a mural for The Drawing Center in New York, NY, and seen her art shown in group exhibitions at The Museum of Modern Art, New York, the Royal Academy of Arts in London, and the 2nd Berlin Biennale in Berlin Germany. She also recently presented solo exhibitions at the Miles McEnery Gallery, New York, NY, the Susquehanna Art Museum, Harrisburg, PA, and the Kavi Gupta Gallery, Chicago, IL, among other places...

**Chris Lloyd** (b. 1994) is a multimedia artist and photographer based in Brooklyn, NY. He often plays with themes of nostalgia and personal narrative by manipulating and layering found material. He currently has a show at Gern en Regalia, New York, NY. He has shown in a solo show at Ed Varie Gallery in Manhattan, and group shows at New Image Art in LA, Cassandra in Toronto, and most recently at Gern and Regalia in Manhattan.

**Claire Tabouret** received her B.F.A. from the École Nationale Supérieure des Beaux-Arts, Paris, in 2006. She has presented work in group exhibitions in Spain, France, the U.K., the U.S., Canada, and other places. She has presented solo exhibitions internationally, recently in Japan, the U.S., and France and is included in numerous private and institutional collections in the U.S. and internationally.
