until April 17, 2021. Hosted in partnership with Palazzo Monti, a cultural center and residency program in Brescia, Italy, and curated

by founder Edoardo Monti, Transatlantico celebrates two artist communities joining forces to celebrate cultural exchange across the Atlantic.
